Recreation and Parks Facility Repair Division recently converted this seasonal pool to a year-round pool at a cost of \$1.3 million. The work included enclosing two locker rooms with a new roof, rebuilding restrooms and shower area, and upgrading the facility for ADA compliance. The Department replaced the hot and cold water lines and installed a new sewer line; replaced the electrical system in the facility; replaced the pumps and filters; installed a new pool heater and gas lines. The Facility Repair Division replaced the entire pool deck, and the parking lot and facility lighting; they installed new concrete floors and surfaces in the building, and installed new windows throughout. The Department installed a forced air heater in the building and painted the entire facility, inside and outside.
