# SEASONAL POOL MANAGER II

(Code No. 2408)

This position is exempt from civil service.\*

## THIS EXAMINATION IS GIVEN TO FILL SUMMER 2023 SWIMMING POOL POSITIONS ONLY

**SALARY:** \$31.77/hour (The current salary is subject to change. You may confirm the starting salary with the hiring department before accepting a job offer).

**DUTIES:** Supervise the operation of a municipal pool; train and supervise aquatic facility staff; act as a lifeguard; develop, promote, direct and conduct pool programs in swimming, lifesaving, swim team, springboard diving, synchronized swimming, and water polo; enforce rules, policies and codes related to municipal swimming pool operations.

As a condition of employment, a Pool Manager II must attend all in-service trainings and must work a minimum of 40 hours (does not include paid training time such as orientation; HO, CPTO/VC, PL or SK Hours) between Opening Day and Labor Day in order to continue employment with Citywide Aquatics.

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. EXPERIENCE:
  - Two (2) full summer seasons paid experience as a Pool Manager I with the City of Los Angeles; and,
  - American Red Cross Lifeguard Management online course Due by May 27, 2023; and,
  - Attend all mandatory manager trainings and maintain a LA City lifeguard Certification
- 2. CERTIFICATION: Proof of American Red Cross Lifeguard Management online course is required and must be uploaded to <u>http://bit.ly/CWATrainingSurvey</u> by May 27, 2023.

## 3. EXAMINATION:

**ORAL INTERVIEW:** Weighted 100%; a minimum score of 80% is required to be placed on the eligibility list.
