JOB DESCRIPTION

- Supervise the operation of a municipal pool; train and supervise aquatic facility staff; act as a lifeguard, coach, Instructor, or coordinator; develop, promote, direct and conduct pool programs including swim lessons, lifesaving, novice and usa level programs, swim team, springboard diving, artistic swimming, and water polo; enforce rules, policies of each sport and there governing body and codes related to municipal swimming pool operations.
- Work assignment will be with the TSLA program. This position will work closely with Citywide Aquatics Team Sports coordinator; the Aquatic Facility Manager; and coach at each of the sites they visit.
- As a condition of employment, a pool manager must attend all in-service trainings, workshops, and be available for the entire year.
- Pool Manager IIs must be available to work 15 - 20 hours per week.



REQUIREMENTS

- Two (2) full seasons paid experience as a Pool Manager I, Pool Manager II or Open Water Lifeguard II with the City of Los Angeles.
- Three (3) full seasons or more coaching experience USA/ College/High School/ Novice or competitive sport participant experience ie: USA/College/High School/ International
