- Determine that the proposed Project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article III, Section 1, Class 11(6) [Placement of minor structures accessory to (appurtenant to) existing institutional facilities] of City CEQA Guidelines and Article 19, Section 15311 of California CEQA Guidelines and direct RAP staff to file a Notice of Exemption (NOE);
- 4. Authorize RAP's Chief Accounting Employee to prepare a check to the Los Angeles County Clerk in the amount of \$75.00 for the purpose of filing an NOE; and,
- 5. Authorize RAP staff to make technical corrections as necessary to carry out the intent of this Report.

### SUMMARY

South Victoria Park is a 0.26-acre park located at 6537 South Victoria Avenue in the South Los Angeles community of the City of Los Angeles. This 0.26-acre facility provides a playground with play equipment, walking paths, benches, and a mini basketball court. Approximately 8,021 City residents live within a one-half mile walking distance of South Victoria Park. Due to the size of the park, and the facilities, features, programs, and services it provides, South Victoria Park meets the standards for a Neighborhood Park, as defined in the City's Public Recreation Plan.

# PROJECT SCOPE

The proposed scope of work for the Project is the installation of shade structures including two (2) shade umbrellas that are proposed to be added over the existing play area and three (3) freestanding shade umbrellas throughout the rest of the park.

# **PROJECT FUNDING**

Upon approval of this Report, Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) in Park Fees can be committed to the proposed Project.

These Park Fees were collected within two (2) miles of South Victoria Park, which is the standard distance for the commitment of Park Fees for neighborhood recreational facilities pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 12.33 E.3

## **PROJECT CONSTRUCTION**

RAP Staff has determined that sufficient funding has been identified and construction of the proposed Project is anticipated to begin in December 2020.

### TREES AND SHADE

This proposed Project will have no impact on the existing trees at South Victoria Park. Approximately five (5) new shade structures will be added to South Victoria Park.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT**

The proposed Project consists of the placement of minor structures accessory to (appurtenant to) existing institutional facilities. As such, RAP staff recommends that the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners (Board) determines that it is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article III, Section 1, Class 11(6), of City CEQA Guidelines and Article 19, Section 15311 of California CEQA Guidelines. RAP staff will file an NOE with the Los Angeles County Clerk upon the Board's approval.

### FISCAL IMPACT

The approval of this commitment of Park Fees will have no fiscal impact on RAP's General Fund. The estimated costs for the design, development, and construction of the proposed park improvements are anticipated to be funded by Park Fees or funding sources other than the RAP's General Fund. The maintenance of the proposed park improvements can be performed by current staff with minimal impact to existing maintenance service at this facility.
