SUMMARY

KT Trading, Inc. (KT Trading) is a general wholesaler established in California in 2018 that provides essential items such as face masks, gloves, hand sanitizer, alcohol wipes and paper towels to businesses around the world.

On August 18, 2020, KT Trading made the Donation to the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) for the participants of the Safer at Parks – Alternative Learning Center and After School Program.
