SUMMARY

Good Sports, Inc., in collaboration with Dick’s Sporting Goods Foundation generously donated 1,400 softball and baseball kits to participants of the Department of Recreation and Parks’ (RAP) 60 Alternative Learning Centers. Softball Kits included: 1 glove, 1 pair of batting gloves, 1 pair of pants, 1 T-shirt, 1 sports bra, 1 pack of face masks, 1 pair of shoelaces and 1 water bottle. Baseball kits included: 1 glove, 1 pair of batting gloves, 1 pair of pants, 1 T-shirt, 1 pack of face masks, 1 pair of shoelaces and 1 water bottle. A drop-off event was held at Evergreen Recreation Center using Dick’s Sporting Goods Foundation “giving truck”. The total estimated value of the donated items is \$100,000.00.
