### SUMMARY

Paul and Mike Burgis worked for CWA in the early 2000's as lifeguards at the Sylmar Swimming Pool as well as Open Water Lifeguard and Pool Managers later in their service to the City. They are now successful business professionals who believe in giving back to the community in which they grew up in. The Burgis brothers are proud supporters of RAP's Aquatic Programs at Sylmar Swimming Pool.

The benefit of this Donation enabled the Sylmar Swimming Pool to provide free admission to 3,313 youth, 1,338 adults, and 140 seniors and people with disabilities during the 2021 Summer Season. In addition, 47 youth received free enrollments into youth competitive sports (Junior Lifeguards, Artistic Swimming, and Swimming).
